Experience a close-up encounter of the *Wolf Capital of the World* – where we spend the week learning about this polarizing creature. You'll spend this jam-packed trip:

- Learning how to call out to wolves (you might even hear them call back)
- Learning about the indigenous teachings of the Mahihkan (wolf in Cree)
- Snowshoeing at the Boreal Discovery Centre, the future home of a wolf-sanctuary.

Between exploring this majestic animal's beauty, you will see Thompson through snowmobiling, ice fishing and dogsledding (with 100% pure Canadian huskies - one of the closest dogs to the wolf).
