

CALM AIR CARL MORBERG MEMORIAL BURSARY PROGRAM DETAILS

Carl Arnold Lawrence Morberg and his wife Gail were the founding members of **Calm Air International LP**. The company started in 1962 in nearby Stony Rapids to move guests and supplies to the Morberg's fishing camp on Black Lake, Saskatchewan. Arnold passed away in September of 2005, but Gail and the company continued in their home base until they were acquired by Exchange Income Corporation (EIC) in 2009. Calm Air connects Manitoba and the North, which includes Nunavut and the Kivalliq region.

The **Calm Air Carl Morberg Memorial Bursary Program** will be awarding up to **five bursaries of \$5000** to individuals pursuing post-secondary education in one of the following areas:

- Aircraft Maintenance Engineer;
- Aircraft Structures Technician;
- Avionics Technology; or
- Commercial Pilot License.

Candidates must meet **one** of the following criteria, and be able to provide supporting documentation, to be considered eligible for the bursary. Applicants with Inuit or Indigenous ancestry will be given priority.

- Permanently reside in Nunavut;
- Permanently reside in Manitoba and be of Indigenous or Inuit ancestry; or
- Currently hold a full-time permanent position with Calm Air for a minimum of one (1) year prior to the application deadline.

Candidates must also meet **all** of the following criteria, and be able to provide supporting documentation, to be considered eligible for the bursary.

- Must be a minimum of 18 years old;
- Must have successfully completed High School with a Grade 12 Diploma or equivalent;
- Must be able to obtain and maintain a Restricted Area Identify Card (RAIC) or enhanced security clearance; and
- Must have proof of enrolment in a Canadian recognized post-secondary Institution

Candidates pursuing their Commercial Pilot License must also provide **all** of the following supporting documentation:

- Transport Canada Category 1 Aviation Medical;
- Restricted Operator Certificate – Aeronautical (ROC -A);
- Canadian Private Pilot License (PPL); and
- Transport Canada English Proficiency.

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Selection will be based on a review of a candidate's submission of a **professional resume** **AND** a **750-word essay** outlining the following:

- Your aviation history and goals;
- Where you see yourself in 5 to 10 years;
- How the bursary will help you achieve your objective, and your present financial need for training;
- How was your previous training financed? Please include all educational scholarships, awards, and honors;
- Where would you obtain the training? Please include all costs including a detailed cost estimate from the post-secondary institution if available; and
- Demonstrated involvement in aviation activities or volunteer work.

All applications must be received by September 15 annually for consideration. All successful applicants will be notified by email after the closing date and dispersion of funds for all successful candidates will be paid directly to the post-secondary institution.
